



165. Grassi-Stratta Gully on the Brèche du Carabinier. IV 4. 350 m.

Gian-Carlo Grassi and Carlo Stratta, 19 September 1985.
Go up the glacier between Pointe Adolphe Rey and the Pyramide du Tacul to the foot of the imposing N face of the Petit Capucin. Take the diagonal couloir (50°), then climb a gully (25 m at 70°/75°). Continue up the couloir to the foot of the serac. Go straight over the serac, or round its left edge, to get to the upper glacier. Continue easily to the Brèche du Carabinier.

166. À La Recherche Du Temps Perdu. V 5. 250 m.

François Damilano and Gian-Carlo Grassi, 25 October 1989.
Go up the glacier between Pointe Adolphe Rey and the Pyramide du Tacul. Climb the middle of the large serac to get to the small, glacial hanging plateau. Descend via the E couloir of the Brèche du Carabinier.

167. Mastabas. M7. 250 m.

Jon Bracey and Matt Helliker, 18 February 2015.
A mixed and dry combination of rock routes. Start by climbing the first pitch of the rock route Le Ronfleur Paradoxal, then follow the obvious mixed line to finish on the E ridge near the summit.
Descent: abseil down the route (3 abseils).

168. Pyramixte.

P1, snow slope then step, belay at the foot of the corner. P2, icy corner. P3, mixed and dry to join *Mixte à la Pinelli-Sabbadini*.

169. Mixte à la Pinelli-Sabbadini. III 5, M5+. 250 m.
