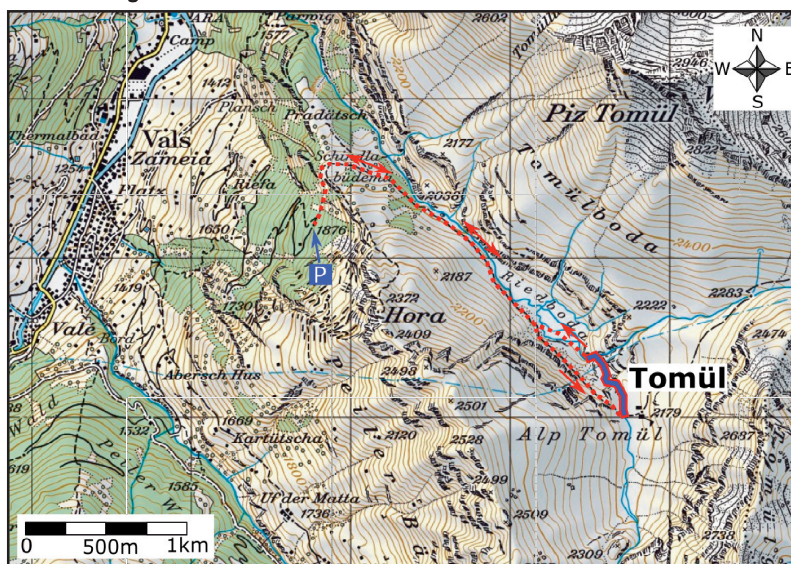


TOMÜLBACH

Vals, Graubünden

The canyon is rather short, but it has some sporty sections, nice clear water and even a short underground section.



Approach:

From Vals take the small mountain road up to the marked car park (alt. 1876Hm). It is also possible to take a hiking taxi, which usually runs on weekends. From the car park always along the hiking trail to the stone bridge shortly before the Alp Tomül. 5 minutes further and a visit of the Alp Tomül for a fresh beer and Alp cheese is recommendable.

Description:

Tomül is a rather short but sporty canyon above the famous thermal baths of Vals. In the Tomül canyon you get the whirlpools and massage jets for free. The start begins comfortably with a few small slides and jumps until the canyon continues underground for about 30m because large boulders lie above the gorge. From then the canyon becomes a bit more technical, especially the C25 can be quite challenging at high water levels.

At the end there is another beautiful spot with a C15 which can also be jumped optionally.

Way back:

From the end of the canyon continue on the plain for 400m to reach the hiking trail you have walked up, then go down to the car.

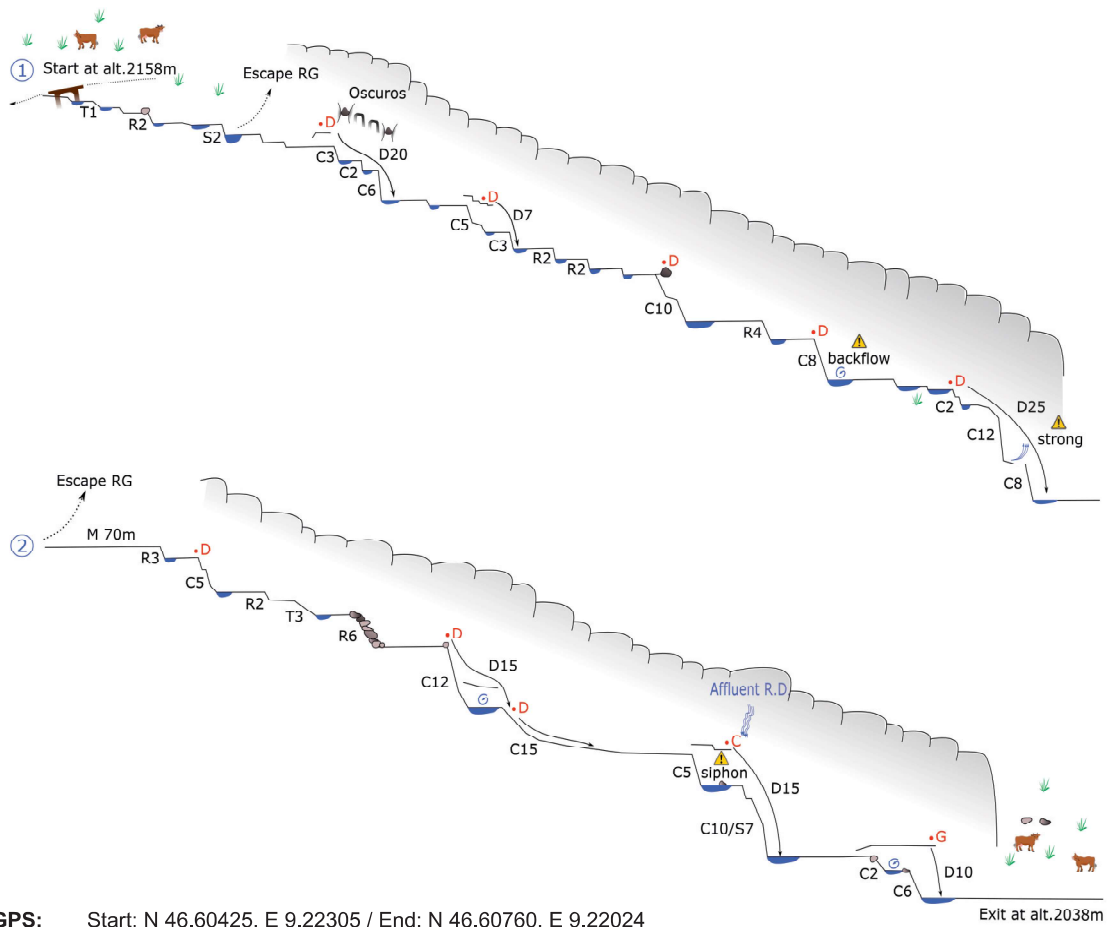
